Miami County, Troy, Ohio, March 20, 2015 – An assessment team from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA), Communications Accreditation Program, will arrive on March 22, 2015 to examine all aspects of the Miami County Communication Center's policy and procedures, management, operations and support services, Director Jeffrey J.
