**GRADES 1 & 2: (JUNIORS)**

- Coach Pitch and Batting Tee.
- Coaches will pitch 4 pitches to each batter and then a tee is used.
- Games are tentatively scheduled to be played at Duke Park on Monday and Tuesday evenings beginning June 8<sup>th</sup>. There may be a game or two scheduled on Saturdays.

**GRADES 3 & 4: (MINORS)**

- Player Pitch and Coach Pitch with an 11" ball.
- Players will pitch the 1<sup>st</sup> 3 pitches to each batter and then the coach will pitch 5 pitches. Swinging strikes against the player pitcher will not be counted. Then the batter has 5 coach pitches. If players don't swing at any player pitches they will have one strike when the coach starts pitching. After 3 strikes or 5 coaches' pitches the batter is out.
- Games are tentatively scheduled to be played at Duke Park on Monday and Tuesday evenings beginning June 8<sup>th</sup>. There may be a game or two scheduled on Saturdays.

**GRADES 5 & 6: (MAJORS) (Pending League Acceptance)**

- Player Pitch with 11" ball.
- High School rules.
- Home games are played at North Market Street softball fields. A scheduling meeting will take place in March. Games will begin in May. A post season league tournament will be played in late June.

**GRADES 7 & 8: (SENIORS) (Pending League Acceptance)**

- High School rules.
- Home games are played at North Market Street softball fields. A scheduling meeting will take place in March. Games will begin in May. A post season league tournament will be played around the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July.
