THE INTIATION PROGRAM

The Initiation Program is for the beginning hockey player who is between 5 and 8 years old as of December 31, 2010. The instructional program will be focused primarily on the basic hockey skills – skating, stick handling, passing and shooting. Each skill is introduced and refined in a progressive “one-step-at-a-time” manner. Players participate in practice drills, informal and modified programs. Although the main emphasis is on fun and progressive skill development, the Initiation Program also allows youngsters to experience:

Cooperation – fair play – fitness – safety.

This program will have one 50 minute practice per week depending upon the facility ice availability (approximately 20 practices for the season). The season is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of September 20th.

Depending upon the number of registrations and available opponents – if possible, there may be a couple of games played against other Initiation Programs at the end of the season.

Required equipment: HECC (Hockey Equipment Certification Council) Helmet with face mask (full cage) and strap, mouthpiece, hockey skates, stick, gloves, pads (elbow and shoulder), shin guards, padded hockey pants, and athletic supporter. Girls will be required to wear a chest protector. Rental equipment is available through the Jr. Hockey Parent’s Association. 5, 6, 7, and 8 year olds who may grow out of this program may have the opportunity to move onto the Mite house team(s) if there are available openings. An additional fee to move up would be assessed as appropriate.

The Initiation Program may have cross ice practices due to the number of participants in the Jr. Hockey program.
