The Brukner Nature Center is a privately funded nonprofit organization dedicated to environmental education and wildlife rehabilitation located just 5 miles west of Troy, Ohio off of State Route 55.

Hours of operation are Monday - Saturday 9:00am to 5:00pm and Sunday 12:30 - 5:00pm.

The 165 acre preserve encompasses a variety of habitats from prairie and woodland to pine forest and wetland providing homes for a diversity of wildlife. Over six miles of hiking trails are available to the public year round from sunrise to sunset. The Interpretive Building houses a nature shop, auditorium, library and exhibits. Brukner Nature Center's Wildlife Rehabilitation Unit offers rehabilitation and care for injured or orphaned native Ohio wildlife.
