SUBJECT: **OPWC ROUND 39 GRANT APPLICATION – WEST MARKET STREET (SR55) WIDENING PHASE 1**

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council authorizes the Director of Public Service and Safety to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for funding of the West Market Street (SR55) Corridor Improvement Project Phase 1 and to execute any necessary agreements if funds are awarded.

BACKGROUND:

The City plans to apply for OPWC funding the multi-year project of improvements to the West Market Street (SR 55) corridor. The scope of the West Market Street Corridor Improvement Project will include the widening of roadway with new curb, gutter, sidewalks and/or recreation trail improvements as well as associated storm water piping. Sanitary and water lines will be relocated as necessary for conflict points.

For OPWC Round 39 (applications due August 5), staff will request funding for the Phase I improvements. Phase I is the area of West Market Street between Parkview Drive and 2433 West Market Street. A portion of Phase I, between Parkview Drive and Kenton Way, will just be striping changes to match the new roadway configuration.

The pre-design estimate for Phase I is approximately \$1,981,061, with \$600,000 being requested in OPWC funding. \$600,000 is the maximum amount of funding that can be awarded for Round 39 construction. The project would be designed in 2025, for construction in 2026. The City will be responsible for funding the project design, and design funding will be included in the 2025 budget.

REQUESTED ACTION:

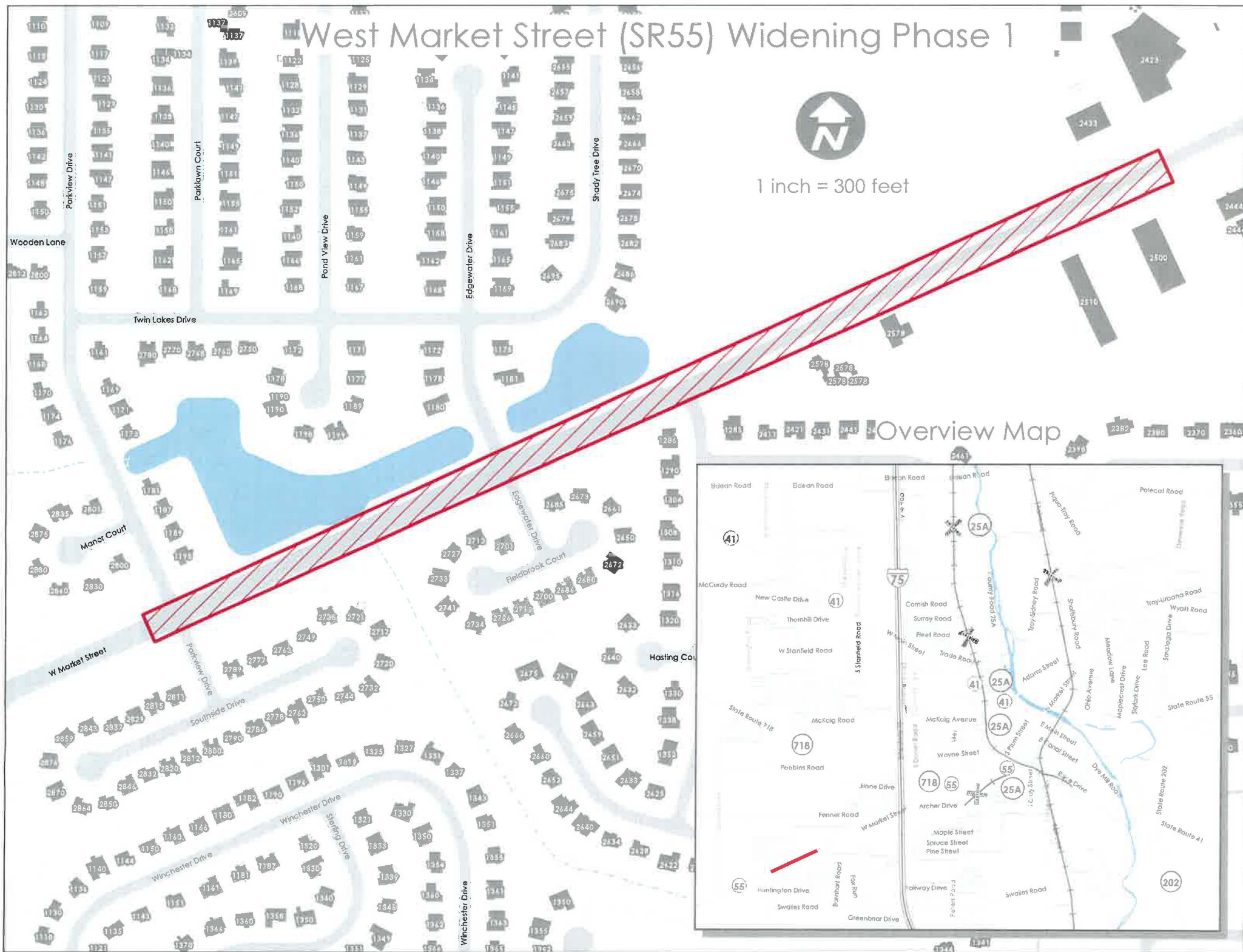
