SUBJECT: **OPWC ROUND 40 GRANT APPLICATION – WEST MARKET STREET (SR55) WIDENING, PHASE 2**

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council authorizes the Director of Public Service and Safety to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for funding of Phase 2 of the West Market Street (SR55) Widening Project and to execute any necessary agreements if funds are awarded.

BACKGROUND:

For OPWC Round 40, staff is requesting funds to make improvements to West Market Street between 2433 and 2310 West Market Street. A location map is attached. This is the second phase of a multi-phase project with the pre-design estimate at \$1,980,583, and \$600,000 being requested in OPWC funding. The schedule is that the project would be designed in 2026 for construction in 2027.

The scope of this project primarily includes the widening of roadway with new curb, gutter, sidewalks and/or recreation trail improvements, as well as associated storm water piping. Sanitary and water lines will be relocated as necessary for conflict points. This will be the second of a multi-phase project to incorporate complete street changes on the West Market Street corridor. The final application has to be uploaded into the OPWC system by October 6, 2025; therefore, consideration of emergency legislation is requested.

REQUESTED ACTION:

It would be appreciated if you would assign to a Committee of Council authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to submit an application to OPWC for funding for Phase 2 of the West Market Street (SR55) Widening Project, and to execute any necessary agreements if funding is received. Based on the application deadline, consideration of emergency legislation is requested.

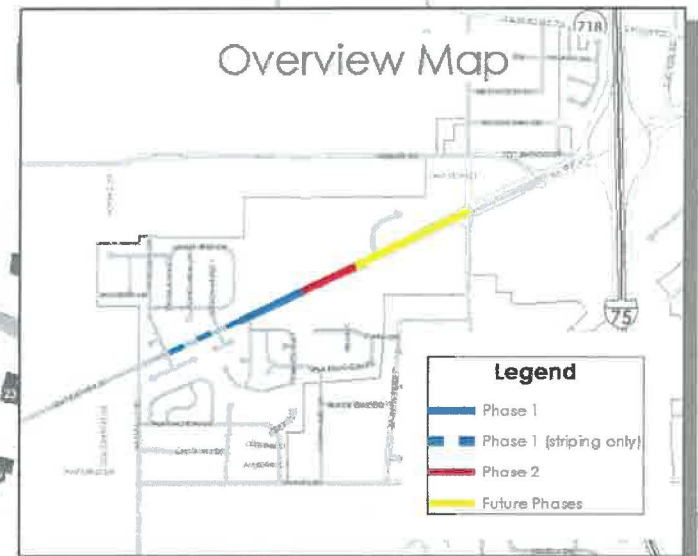
West Market Street (SR55) Widening Phase 2
