MINUTES OF HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION

A regular session of the Human Relations Commission was held at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, City Hall.

Members Attending: Keller, Major, Severt, Holycross.

Presiding Officer: Chairperson Sonia Holycross

Others Attending: City Staff

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting commenced at 6:06 p.m. by the Chairperson's call to order.

MINUTES: Upon motion of Mr. Severt, seconded by Mr. Major, the September 25, 2024, minutes were approved by the Commission unanimously, having no corrections or additions to these minutes.

INITIATIVES: The Commission members discussed the completed, ongoing, and future initiatives.

Ms. Holycross stated that the Commission is working to collect information on how the HRC could assist or connect with the Juneteenth team or IDEA to help revive the Festival of Nations. Ms. Villalobos said at the August 8 meeting that she would connect with former members of the Festival of Nations planning team, Mr. Major will also assist in that work.

The Troy Foundation is developing a committee to plan a community-based Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion training with professional development educator Karen Townsend. Ideally, the training will be open to the HRC, City staff, and leaders in various community organizations. Planning will begin in 2025.

MEETINGS: The next HRC meeting will be held on November 13, 2024. Ms. Holycross and other available Commission members plan to meet with Mayor Oda before that meeting to discuss the nomination of new members.

COMMISSION MEMBER COMMENTS: Mr. Severt stated that the Festival of Nations is still an incorporated 501(c)3 and that most 501(c)3 incorporations last for five years. Mr. Severt also mentioned that a public hearing concerning potential legislation on recreational marijuana operators will be held on November 4 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: No public comments were provided.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:17 p.m.

Subject: 2024 ANNUAL REPORT

On behalf of the City of Troy Human Relations Commission (HRC), and in compliance with Section 135.05 of the City of Troy Codified Ordinances, I am pleased to forward the following review of the HRC's 2024 activities.

The current HRC appointees are Kane Feltner (Secretary), Sonia Holycross (Chairperson), Jon Keller (Vice-Chairperson), Marvin Major, Sr., Todd Severt, and Ruby Villalobos. Mr. Severt is resigning from the Commission at the end of 2024. Mr. Feltner's term expires on December 31, 2024, and he will not seek reappointment due to other commitments. At the first meeting in January 2025, the Commission will elect a new chairperson, vice-chairperson, and secretary. The Commission scheduled six meetings in 2024, convening on four occasions due to quorum concerns.

The HRC webpage allows community members to contact the Commission via email or fill out a form to report a complaint or issue related to the HRC's Chapter 135.06 list of duties. The HRC received three complaints, which were forwarded to the appropriate governmental body or organization for follow-up.

The HRC has been in contact with the Ohio History Connection Office regarding the historical marker honoring 54th and 55th Regiments African American soldiers buried at the Soldiers Circle at Riverside Cemetery, Section 11. The marker is in production, and the Chairperson will be notified when it is ready to be shipped. The HRC plans to erect the marker in June 2025 and have a celebratory unveiling. The date of the unveiling has yet to be set.

The members of the HRC are proud of the work that has been accomplished during the past four years and remain committed to fulfilling the duties outlined in Chapter 135. I am available for any questions or concerns and would gladly make myself available for a presentation to you and Troy City Council at your convenience.

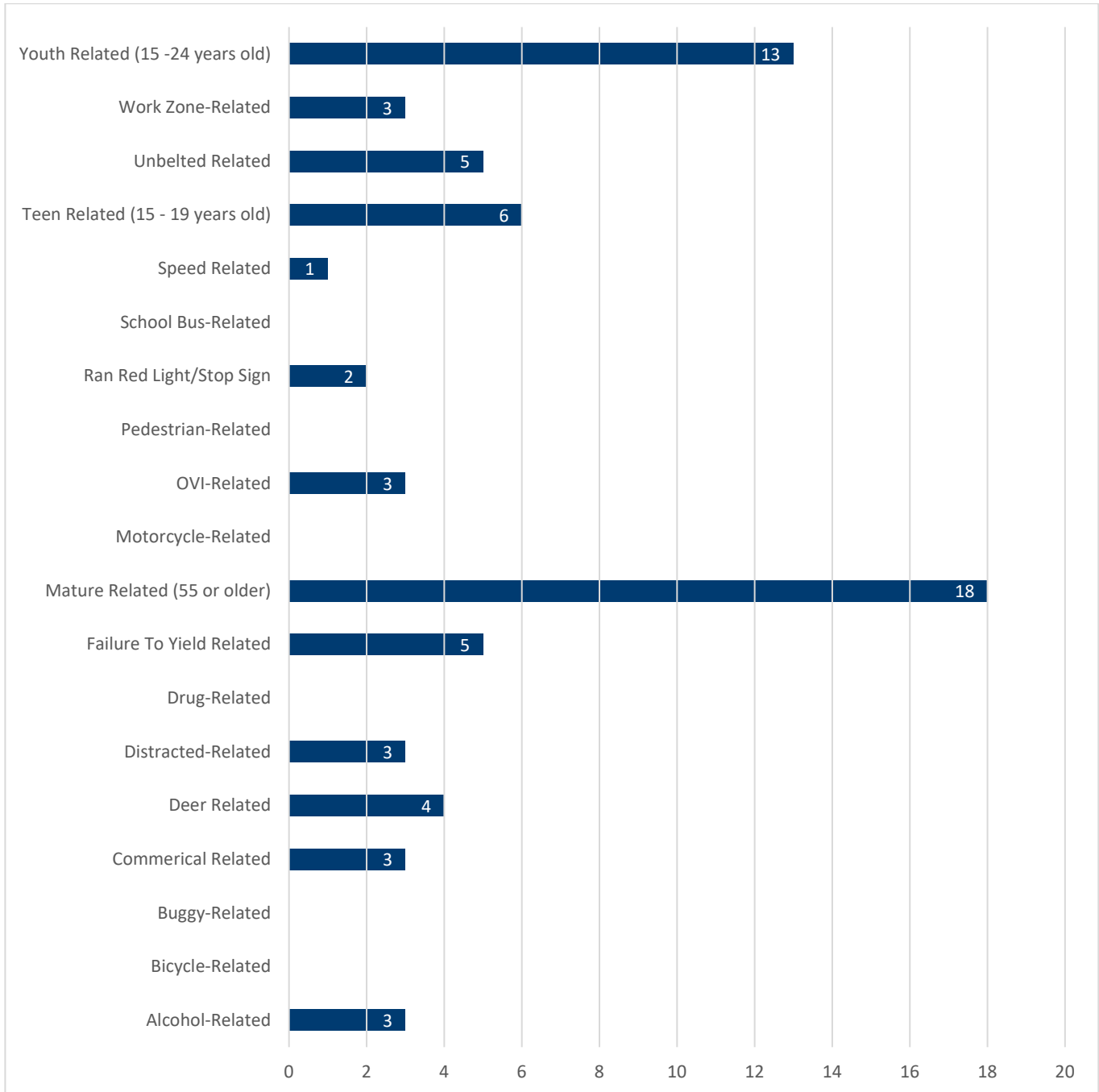
