

## Treasure Island 2020 Summer Concert Event FAQs

### **Q: How much do the concert events cost?**

There is no admission fee for the concert events. Tickets are not required.

### **Q: Do we bring our own chairs?**

There is no reserved seating. There is a tiered area directly in front of the performance area. The levee side will also be used as seating areas for these events. Lawn chairs or blankets are recommended. Chairs may be placed in the amphitheater area. On Friday, June 26th, the concert will begin at 7:30pm and is being presented as part of the entertainment options for the Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure. On Saturday, July 4th, the show will begin at 8pm and will lead into the fireworks which are scheduled for approximately 10pm. The amphitheater area is open beginning at 6pm on August 1st and the show begins at 7:30pm. Seating areas are not covered, and lawn seating may become wet.



### **Q: Do the shows still go on when it rains?**

Event staff and crew will make every attempt to present the scheduled events "rain or shine." Performances are not moved indoors or rescheduled.

Performances may be interrupted or delayed for up to one hour due to inclement weather. When summer storms are severe, or when danger is presented to the audience/performers due to lightning or high winds etc., performances may be cancelled.

Programs and artists are subject to change without notice. Call the Recreation Department weather line at 937.339.5145. If the event is cancelled it will be included on this weather line and on this webpage.

**Q: I am coming from out of town. How do I get to Treasure Island Park?**

Those using GPS may enter 439 North Elm Street, Troy, OH 45373.

Directions to Treasure Island:

Take I75 to Exit #74

Take St. Rt. 41 Towards Troy

Turn Left on Elm St. (CVS on Right hand Corner)

Treasure Island Park will be on the right-hand side just past the Eagles club.

**Q: Do you sell food and drinks?**

Food vendors will be on site at Treasure Island Park for each concert event. (Beer will also be available at the August 1st concert event.)

**Q: Can I bring Beer and/or wine and/or alcohol to the Park?**

Under Ohio Law, consumption of alcoholic beverages at the concert events is restricted to beverages sold under state license at the concession areas located at the venue.

***Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into Treasure Island Park or to the event held at Treasure Island Park.***

**Q: Where do I park?**

**General Parking:** General public parking will be available, non-reserved, first-come, first-served basis, in the Hobart Arena parking lot for concert events. Parking is also available in the Troy Community Park. Street parking is also available in the neighborhood located across Elm Street from Treasure Island Park.

**Disabled Parking:** A limited number of parking spaces for vehicles with state issued disabled parking tags will be permitted at Treasure Island Park. Enter the park entrance at 439 N. Elm Street.

**Q: Will wheel chairs access be available?**

Wheelchair access will be available with a limited number of wheelchair seating spaces at the amphitheater; designated and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Q: Are restrooms available?**

Public restrooms will be available at Treasure Island Park during events.

**Q: Is smoking permitted?**

Smoking will not be permitted in the amphitheater area of the park during concert events.

**Q: Will First Aid be available?**

Bike Medics will be covering the park area during concert events.

**Q: What Security will be in place?**

All bags will be checked upon entry into the event venue for events in which alcohol is sold.

**Prohibited Items:**

- Coolers (For August 1st show)
- No Carry in Food or Beverage- (1)20 oz. factory sealed bottle of water per person is permitted. The bottle Cannot be frozen. (For August 1st show)
- Recording Devices
- Umbrellas
- Laser Pointers
- Beach Balls and/or inflatables
- Signs
- Selfie Sticks
- Fireworks
- Bikes inside the fenced in area - (August 1st show)
- Any other items deemed dangerous or inappropriate
