SUBJECT: **AUTHORIZATION TO BID MADISON STREET LIFT STATION REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council authorizes the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Madison Street Lift Station Rehabilitation Project at a cost not to exceed \$545,466.

**BACKGROUND:**

This project scope includes the replacement of the upper and lower bearing on the screws and removal and replacement of the grout and splash guards. While the screws are removed for grout replacement they will be also be evaluated for needed repairs. \$545,466 was included in the 2021 budget for the project; but due to the project potentially not being awarded until 2022, the funds have been included in the 2022 budget. This project is being funded in part through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

SUBJECT: **BIDDING AUTHORIZATION – WEST MAIN STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL POLES FOR THE PHASE I PROJECT**

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council authorizes the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for West Main Street Traffic Signal Poles at a total cost not to exceed \$300,000.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City has experienced a supply chain issue in the delivery of the traffic signal poles for the Kings Chapel and Marybill Drive project. Recognizing that traffic signal poles will also be a major component of the West Main Street Improvement Project Phase I, staff is recommending that the traffic signals for that project be bid separate from the construction, and be bid at this time to provide a few months lead time and better ensure delivery for a timely completion of the Phase I project ahead of bidding the Phase 2 project.

This project is budgeted within the Capital Improvement Budget Fund 441 for Calendar Year 2022.

**REQUESTED ACTION:**

It would be appreciated if you would assign to a Committee of Council authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the West Main Street Traffic Signal Poles at a total cost not to exceed \$300,000.
